**Intensive Summer Program:** French as Foreign  
Language and Cultural activities  
**Small groups:** from 8 to 20 students maximum  
**Level groups:** beginner – intermediate – advanced  
**15 hours** a week with qualified native French teachers +  
**Intensive cultural program**  
Each student will receive a certificate at the end of the 4 weeks.  
Our summer program entitles to **6 ECTS Credits**

Dates: **May 31st to June 28th 2022**  
Classes will start on Wednesday 1st June  
Students are required to reach Rennes  
by Monday 30th May  
Program length: **four weeks**

Administrative costs: **300€** upon registration for all participants  
(non-refundable)  
Tuition fees: **1 000€** (free for INSA partner universities' students)  
On-site accommodation : **330€** for the period from Monday 30th May  
to Tuesday 28th June  
Meal pass for the restaurant : about **3€** per meal
